Colorist Vault Creative LUTs

A creative lookup table (LUT) is used to add stylistic and creative looks to your visual. It can be used to add colour contrast or to instill an emotion in a scene.

The Colorist Vault Creative LUTs can be layered over any REC.709 footage which makes it very versatile and practical.




And lastly, it is recommended to set your '3D lookup table interpolation' to 'Tetrahedral'

Workflow

This is the recommended workflow for the Visionary LUTs. The creative LUT should be applied after the technical transformation in a REC.709 colour space down the pipeline.



The creative LUT can be tuned down by using the Key > Output Gain function in Davinci Resolve or by reducing the adjustment layer opacity.

You may also use 'Intensity' sliders to tone down the effect for similiar functions in other softwares.
